Questions and Answers on Citrus All Purpose Cleaner

Question: “What is unique about Citrus All Purpose Cleaner?”

Answer: “Citrus is alkaline-based all-purpose cleaner that contains D-Limonene (a natural citrus solvent) for extra grease and soil cutting power.

Question: “What are all of the ways I can use Citrus?”

Answer: “Citrus is an all-purpose cleaner, so it has many applications. This product cleans all washable hard surfaces, and is also safe to use on most floors: asphalt tile, cork, concrete, rubber, vinyl, linoleum, terrazzo, ceramic and quarry tile. Always read label for instructions before use.

Question: “What is the fragrance in Citrus?”

Answer: Citrus leaves a pleasant, fresh orange scent on whatever it cleans.

Question: “Is Citrus sold as a ready-to-use cleaner?”

Answer: No. Citrus is a concentrated cleaner formulated for dilution with water. For general cleaning, use only 4 ounces in a spray bottle.

Question: “Is Citrus safe to use in pressure washers/power washers?”

Answer: Citrus does a great job in pressure/power washers. Use approximately a 30:1 dilution (30 parts water to 1 part Citrus). If your equipment automatically gives you a dilution and you can't alter that dilution, it is probably a 7:1 dilution (most common). In that case, mix a 4:1 dilution in a bucket and pull that through, making a 28:1 dilution. Make sure to wear eye protection so none of the blend gets in your eyes, and do not leave standing puddles where animals might drink.

Lastly, do not allow runoff to enter storm drains. This is a violation of the Clean Water Act (which states that nothing can be put down a storm drain but rainwater!). Simply push the runoff with your hose or pressure washer to a grassy area and water it in.

Question: “Is Citrus safe to use on hard wood surfaces?”

Answer: Citrus is safe to use on finished wood surfaces. We do not recommend using Citrus on unfinished wood.

Question: “Is Citrus safe to use on marble?”

Answer: Citrus is safe on true, polished marble. However, exercise caution when using Citrus on cultured marble, which is actually a matrix of marble dust or chips and a resin binder. Low-grade cultured marble can sometimes be damaged by Citrus if it stays on the cultured marble for too long.

Question: “Can I use Citrus in the laundry?”

Answer: No, Citrus is not effective with laundry.
