





## **Questions and Answers on Pure Clean**

Question: "What is unique about Pure Clean?"

**Answer:** Pure Clean is Green Seal Certified and meets the Green Seal Standard for Cleaning Products for

Industrial and Institutional Use, GS-37.

Question: "What does it mean to be Green Seal Certified?"

**Answer:** Pure Clean is Green Seal Certified because of its reduced human and environmental toxicity and reduced volatile organic compound content, with skin and eye irritation met at the as-used dilution.

**Question:** "What are all of the ways I can use Pure Clean?"

**Answer:** Pure Clean is an all-purpose cleaner, so it has many applications. It can be used to quickly and effectively clean a variety of surfaces. Pure Clean rapidly penetrates tough soils naturally pulling them into solution so you can wash them away without added corrosive materials. Always read label before use for instructions.

Question: "What is the fragrance in Pure Clean?"

**Answer:** Pure Clean has no fragrance added to it, so it has a mild to no odor.

Question: "Is Pure Clean sold as a ready-to-use cleaner?"

**Answer:** No. Pure Clean is a concentrate formulated for dilution with water. Always read the label before use for

diluting instructions.

Question: "Is Pure Clean safe to use in pressure washers/power washers?"

**Answer:** Pure Clean does a great job in pressure/power washers. Use approximately a 30:1 dilution (30 parts water to 1 part Pure Clean). If your equipment automatically gives you a dilution and you can't alter that dilution, it is probably a 7:1 dilution (most common). In that case, mix a 4:1 dilution in a bucket and pull that through, making a 28:1 dilution. Make sure to wear eye protection so none of the blend gets in your eyes, and do not leave standing puddles where animals might drink.

Lastly, do not allow runoff to enter storm drains. This is a violation of the Clean Water Act (which states that nothing can be put down a storm drain but rainwater!). Simply push the runoff with your hose or pressure washer to a grassy area and water it in.

Question: "Is Pure Clean safe to use on hard wood surfaces?"

**Answer:** Pure Clean is safe to use on finished wood surfaces. We do not recommend using WOW on unfinished wood.

**Question:** "Can I use Pure Clean in the laundry?" **Answer:** Yes, Pure Clean is very effective in laundry.

Question: "Is Pure Clean safe to use on marble?"

**Answer:** Pure Clean is safe on true, polished marble. However, exercise caution when using Pure Clean on cultured marble, which is actually a matrix of marble dust or chips and a resin binder. Low-grade cultured marble can sometimes be damaged by Pure Clean if it stays on the cultured marble for too long.
